Then they share their work with everyone.  3st step: Group questioning on current affairs based on the watching of a video about the freedoms won and not won.  1st step: Each group reflects on one of the topics of the past (before 25 <sup>th</sup> April) and the freedoms won with the April Revolution based on short thematic texts distributed to the students.  2st step: Group discussion on the rights won with the revolution.
