Clermont-Ferrand is located in the central part of France, close to Lyon, a major city in the East of France. Clermont-Ferrand is well-know for its surrounding landscape, with mountains, lakes and a range of ancient volcanoes forming an alignment commonly called the « Chaine des Puy and the Limagne fault tectonic arena » recently admitted as part of the UNESCO heritage. It's population is about 100,000 people.


It is the intellectual center of the area and it has a university and two hospitals.

Kaunas Rokai Gymnasium

Kaunas Rokai gymnasium is located in the outskirts of Kaunas city. Kaunas Rokai gymnasium is like an island of natural and cultural heritage in the community of the city schools. Rokai community has a unique natural heritage (Jiesia Landscape Reserve) and a rich cultural and historic heritage (mounds, fortifications equipment, Bernardine brick works, estates businesses, etc.).

Our gymnasium community consists of 42

teachers and about 470 pupils. Our pupils attend the classes from 1th till 12th grade (7-19 years old).











Kaunas City

Lithuanian city – Kaunas is the administrative, cultural, scientific and business centre of the county. **Kaunas city** is located in the centre of Lithuania, at the confluence of two largest Lithuanian rivers – the Nemunas and the Neris. Kaunas city covers about 1174 ha of protected areas – part of the Kaunas Reservoir Regional Park, landscape and zoological reserves, as well as other protected natural heritage objects. Kaunas's population is about 288 000 people.

The city of Amora, located in the county of Seixal, on the coast of Portugal has about 49 000 people.

It is a very old riverside town, dating from the fourteenth century. Next to the Jewish river that flows into Tejo, the most important river of Portugal, we still find many historical vestiges: tidal mills, old factories, naval yards and the old town house.





Near this city of Amora, we can quickly reach the capital of Portugal (Lisbon) by boat, train or car.

In summer, we can enjoy beautiful beaches and contact with nature in the natural park of Arrábida.

IES La Albericia








La Albericia is a secondary school on the outskirts of Santander in the region of Cantabria. Our school has almost eight hundred students and more than eighty teachers.

Santander






